<b>110 years ago</b>	Dr. Bryce, Medical Health Officer, linked federal health funding inequities to preventable deaths of First Nations children	<b>216 Million</b>	Caring Society estimate of immediate child welfare funding requirements in 2016
<b>71 years ago</b>	Child welfare experts call for increased family support to reduce # of First Nations children in state care	<b>71 Million</b>	Amount for First Nations child welfare investments in Budget 2016 (developed fall 2015)
<b>36 years ago</b>	Expert calls on INAC to resolve jurisdictional disputes resulting in service denials to First Nations children	<b>58.2 Million</b>	Portion of the 71 Million in Budget 2016 actually spent on immediate relief for children and families; INAC uses remaining 12.8M to cover its own costs.
<b>10 years ago</b>	The Assembly of First Nations & Caring Society filed the human rights case v. Canada	<b>382 Million</b>	July 2016 announcement by INAC/Health Canada to address Jordan's Principle cases
<b>2</b>	Number of Auditor General reports confirming child welfare funding inequity since 2008	<b>5+ Million</b>	Amount the federal government actually spent helping children affected by Jordan's Principle cases as of January 2017 (1.3% of announced 382 Million)
<b>165,000+</b>	First Nations children affected by Canada's discriminatory services	<b>3</b>	Number of Canadian Human Rights Tribunal (CHRT) orders requiring Canada to cease its discrimination towards First Nations children since January 2016 (2016 CHRT 2, 10, 16)
<b>25 Million+</b>	Approx. number of nights First Nations children have spent in foster care since 2007	<b>Zero</b>	CHRT orders that Canada has fully complied with
		<b>3</b>	Hearing days set for March 22-24, 2017 to hear further motions regarding Canada's non-compliance
